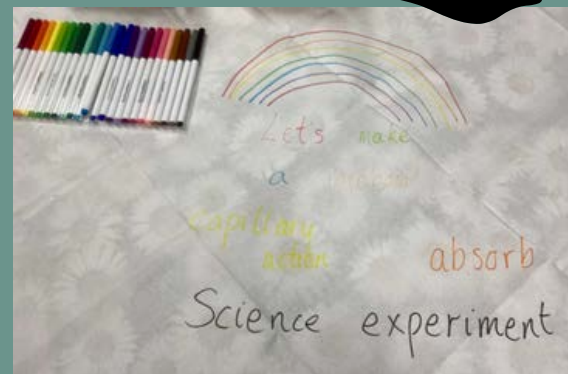

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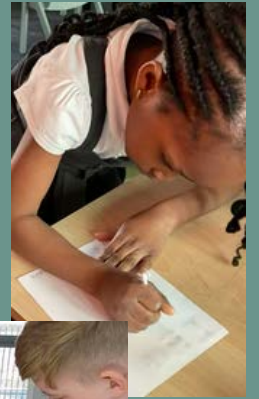

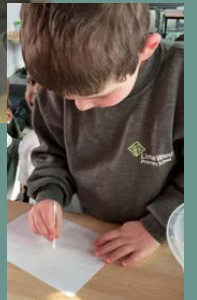
Science Week started with an interactive assembly delivered by Miss Willard and supported by some volunteers to demonstrate an experiment! It was great to hear the children's predictions and observations!



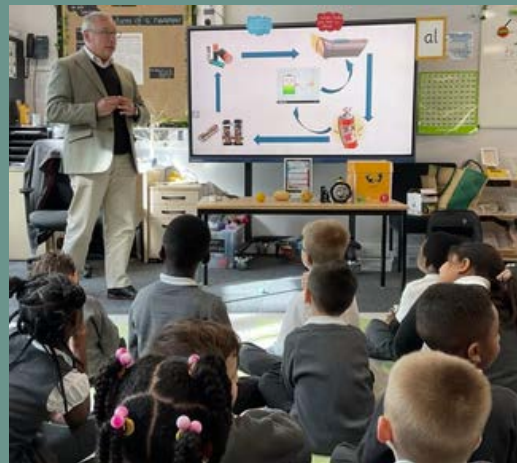
Invisible Ink


