
## WE LOVE LEARNIG Year 1 Maths - Part Whole Model

This model begins to develop the understanding of the commutativity of addition, as children become aware that the parts will make the whole in any order.








Take a look at our Y1 Calculation Document on our website. This document takes you through the progression of skills in Maths and provides examples of how your children are taught to carry out operations in Maths.
