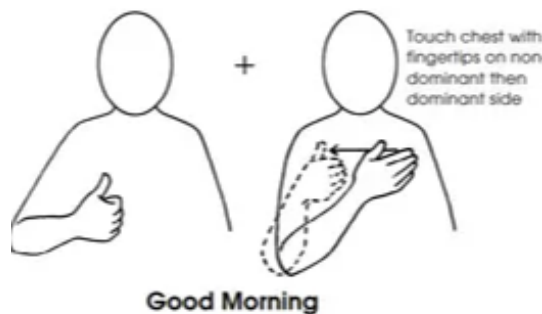


Sign of the Week

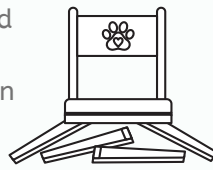
Children made their own character headbands to role play the story.

Children used the sand area to construct a cottage for the three bears.

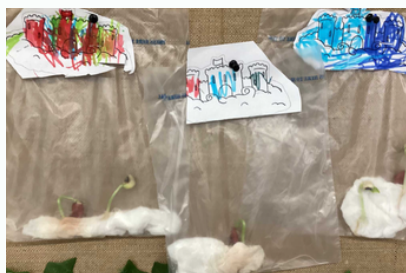


The children's digital skills were used to draw the characters from the text.
