Enjoy the break and see you all on 4th November!

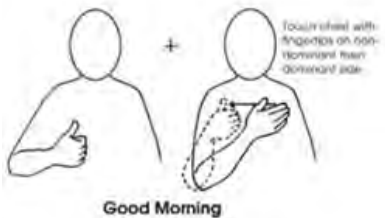
