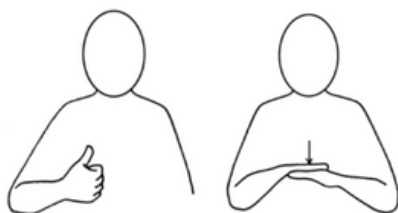

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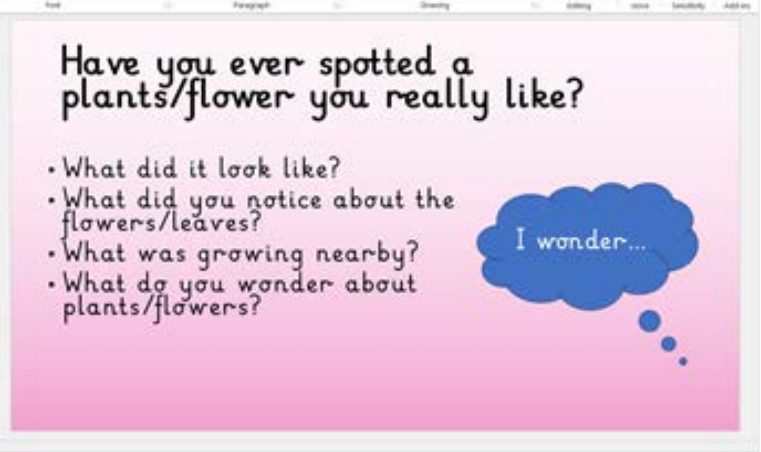
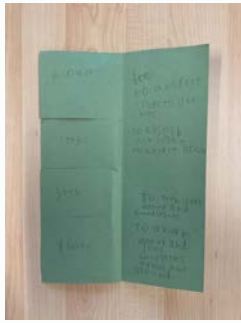

I wonder what would happen if plants drunk coke and juice?

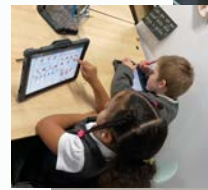
I wonder why some plants crawl? Do they have legs?

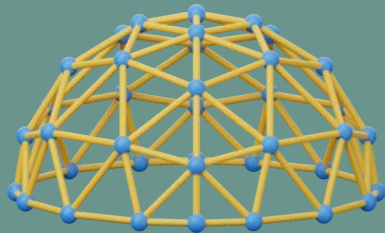
