What a fantastic experience!











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


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SCIENCE WEEK COMPETITION



Understanding Attendance - Explaining Compulsory School Age

A child is of compulsory school age at the start of the term following their fifth birthday. From that date, a child must legally be in receipt of suitable education either by regular attendance at school or otherwise (Section 7 of the Education Act 1996).

A child reaches statutory school age when they turn five. So, for statutory intervention purposes (formal referral or FPNs for holidays in term time), if a child turns five at the start of the Autumn term (i.e. 4th September) and they take a holiday in November, they can be fined as the child is over statutory school age when the holiday was taken as the school place has been accepted, meaning not only are they statutory school age but also have already complied with the rules for compulsory school age and therefore need to follow DfE and school policy for attendance requirements.

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Note to all parents of a child on the SEND Register.
