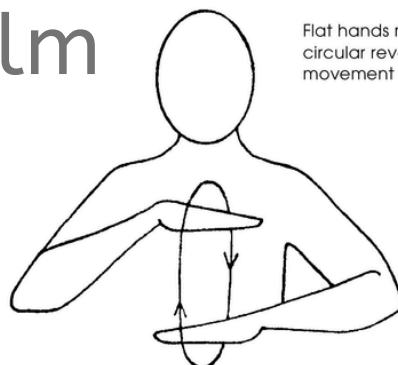

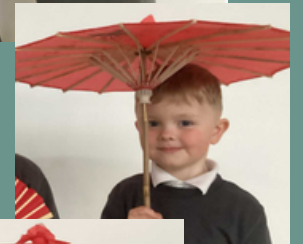

Remember the 5 SMART rules when using the internet and mobile phones.

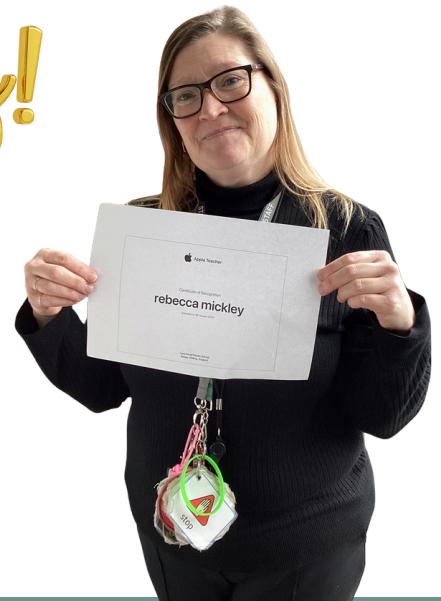
- S SAFE:** Keep safe by being careful not to give out personal information when you're chatting or posting online. Personal information includes your email address, phone number and password.
- M MEET:** Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Only do so with your parents' or carers' permission and even then only when they can be present.
- A ACCEPTING:** Accepting emails, IM messages, or opening files, pictures or texts from people you don't know or trust can lead to problems - they may contain viruses or nasty messages!
- R RELIABLE:** Someone online might lie about who they are, and information on the internet may not be true. Always check information with other websites, books or someone who knows.
- T TELL:** Tell your parent, carer or a trusted adult if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried, or if you or someone you know is being bullied online.

HOW TO MAKE A PAPER LANTERN

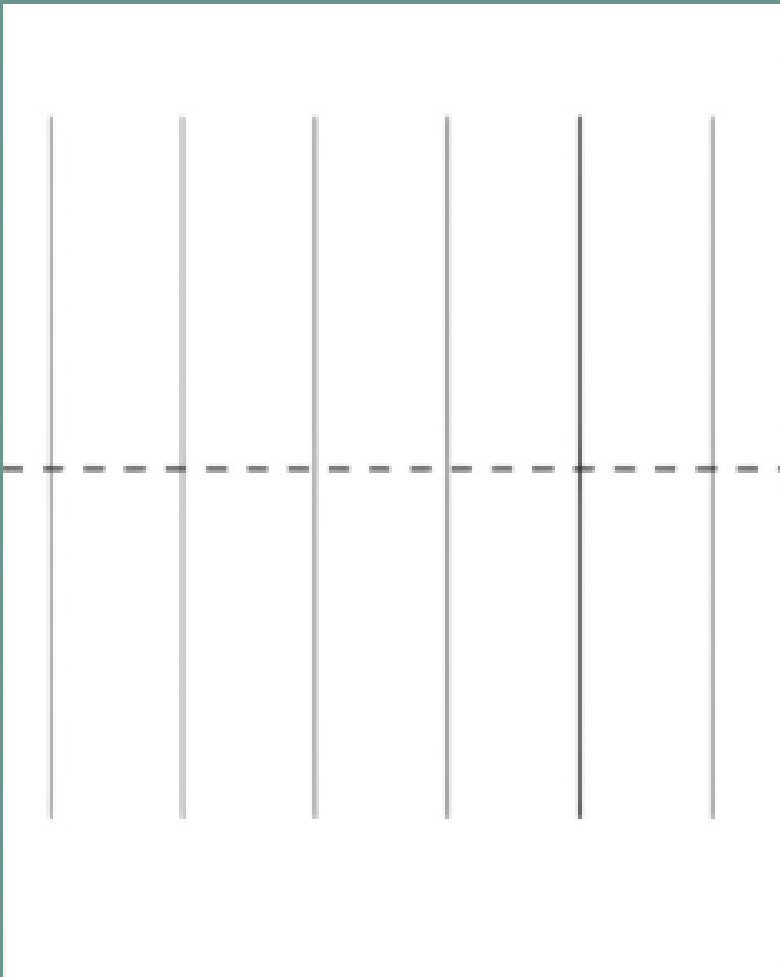


Instructions

1. Start with a rectangular piece of paper - cut a strip of paper from the long edge of the paper.
This will be used as the handle of the lantern.
2. Fold the paper in half lengthwise.
3. Cut strips crosswise.
4. Cut from the folded edge towards the raw edge - be careful to keep the strips connected and not cut each strip off!
5. Unfold the paper.
6. Loop the paper around to form a tube.
7. Join the short ends of the paper together with sellotape or a staple.
8. Tape or stable on the handle (made in step 1!)
9. You are done!
