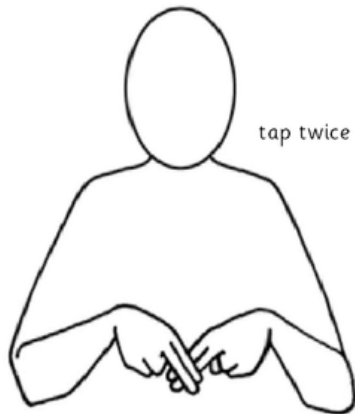

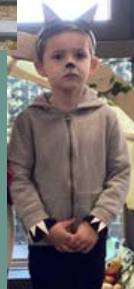


What a fantastic day!

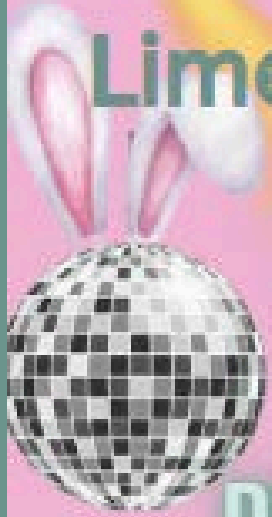
